



SUFFOLK SPORTS HALL OF FAME HONORS TOM SPOTA

The SSHOF is proud to announce that our Honoree this year is Tom Spota, Suffolk County District Attorney. Tom has been an avid supporter over the years and this year has authorized the use of asset forfeiture funds to sponsor an educational and crime prevention film entitled "Bullying & Violence in Our Schools Today". This film will be shown to elementary schools throughout Suffolk County during our field trip programs.

Tom has served as the District Attorney of Suffolk County since January 1, 2002. As the first district attorney in Suffolk County history to receive the endorsement of each political party, Tom was overwhelmingly elected to a second term in 2005, and received similar endorsement in 2009 and was elected to a third term.

Tom's first two terms in office have been marked by successful investigations of government officials, Suffolk County school district administrators, violent street gangs, and heroin traffickers. He earned national recognition by becoming the first district attorney in the United States to empanel a grand jury to investigate victims' claims of sexual abuse by members of the clergy, and the resulting report, critical of the practices and policies of the diocesan hierarchy, was the catalyst for change to make the reporting of sexual misconduct by priest and clergy members mandatory.

Tom's reorganization of the office includes the establishment of a Government Corruption Bureau, an Anti-Street Gang Unit, a Mortgage Fraud Unit, and a Labor Law Enforcement Unit to investigate and prosecute violations of the state's prevailing wage law. In March of 2009, to marshal law enforcement efforts to battle the growing menace of heroin use, Tom formed a multi-jurisdictional task force comprised of prosecutors, district attorney detective-investigators, New York State Police and Drug Enforcement agents. Five months later, the task force recorded the largest seizure of uncut heroin in Suffolk history, seventeen pounds of pure heroin, tracked by investigators to a Melville hotel.

Tom is a graduate of St. John's University School of Law. He began his career in public service in 1978 as an Assistant District Attorney in the Suffolk County District Attorney's office, where he distinguished himself by earning promotion to the job of Chief Trial Prosecutor and Chief of the Homicide Bureau before entering the private sector in 1982.

He is a husband, a father, a prosecutor and a citizen who takes pride in being an American.

The SSHOF intends to work closely with the school districts and individual athletic directors to schedule field trips and tours of our facility. The SSHOF will make available its facilities not only to the youth of Suffolk County, but also to senior citizens and community groups.
